Context

Iberostar has been developing its data-driven strategy for years and has an extensive ecosystem of reports within its organization. At the time they contacted me, they already had a Power BI theme and templates; however, they were undergoing a corporate rebranding process and considered it a good opportunity to standardize and further improve the aesthetics of their reports.

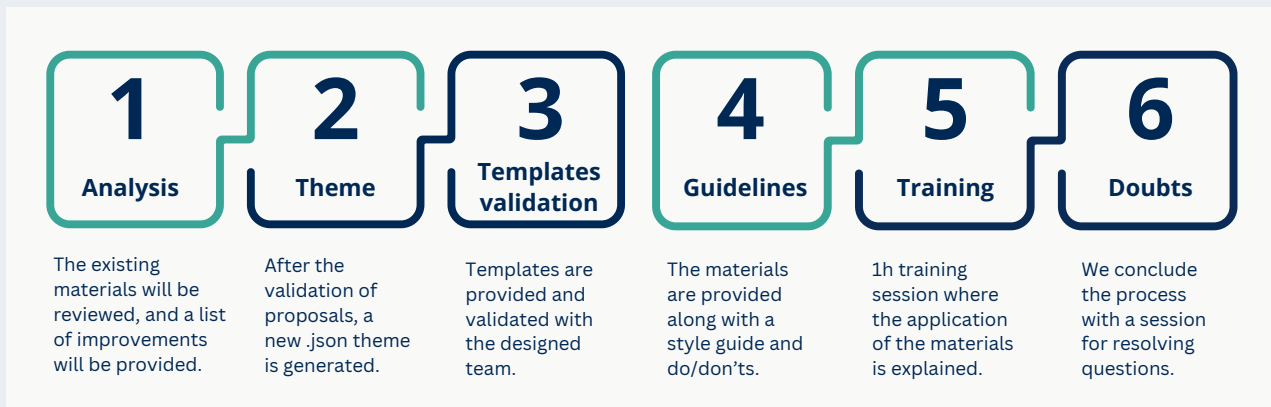
Challenge

The colors provided by design departments are not always the most suitable for a data visualization project, a common issue in many companies. Additionally, Iberostar shares style guides for the various brands within the hotel group, which include a more extensive palette than usual. The challenge lies in integrating their colors with minor adaptations, ensuring contrast, and, above all, maximizing the readability of data in every visualization.



Proposed Solution

As part of my design methodology, I have been working for years on standardizing the rebranding process and the graphic optimization of reports. My proposal is to develop a new JSON theme and design system for Iberostar, structured in the following phases:



Before and after example: when the data analytics team began independently implementing the design system into their existing reports.



These phases are planned in different iterations to gather feedback from users and stakeholders at each stage. Over the course of these six phases, the work involves analysis, validations, delivery of materials, training, and a Q&A session.

Context

In approximately two months, focusing on minimal client involvement to ensure agile iterations, Iberostar is already in the process of implementing the changes within its organization.

The materials provided include:

- The theme in .json format, accommodating the current limitations of Power BI themes.
- Headers, tailored to meet Iberostar's diverse needs.
- Visual styles categorized by type: temporal trends, comparisons, rankings, part-to-whole relationships, cards and KPIs, tables, exploration, etc.
- Button styles and interaction design, including various options for secondary navigation (e.g., adding contextual information, alerts, etc.).

Additionally, along with the delivered Power BI files, a style guide is included to ensure consistent use of colors and key design features. It also contains a do's and don'ts guide with usage examples for any Power BI developer.

Benefits

With minimal involvement in the redesign process, Iberostar now has materials that streamline the design of their reports, allowing developers to focus on what truly matters: the data and its narrative, while spending minimal time on aesthetics and maintenance. Their next step is to adapt the reports to the new style—a tedious task but one significantly simplified thanks to these resources.
